



System of Tertiary Education










CTU in Prague

- best ranking technical university in the country
- 8 faculties
- 176 (in Czech) and 70 (in other languages) study programmes
- 24 000+ students (3 000 international students)
- 1 900 academic staff
- 1 500 non-academic staff
- QS World University Rankings 2014 rank 411-420
 - Civil Engineering rank 50 100
 - Machinery Engineering rank 150 200

Faculty of Architecture


- 1700 students


